1.1 Women in Business (WiB) Followup Coaching

On September 21st 2018, the Women's Centre for Job Creation (WCFJC)conducted its 3rd quarterly Women in Business (WiB) follow-up coaching workshop. The objective was to discuss product characteristics as a basis for the marketing of products and services.Nine members of the Turikilala women group attended the session held at Ms. Hagira Kawala's home in Budondo Sub-county, Jinja District.

1.3 LoanRepayment and Savings

By 30th September 2018, repayments under Loan Phase VIII totaled UGX3,691,000 (US\$ 1,025), equivalent to96% of the total loan amount. Loan recovery is up from UGX 3,622,500 (US\$ 1,006) equivalent to 94% in August 2018.
